Eligibility for Scholarships: Only graduating female students enrolled at Samuel Gompers Vocational and Technical High School in the Bronx, New York who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply for the *Pamela Profit Finer Womanhood Scholarship*.

- ✧ The applicant must be accepted into an accredited 2 or 4-year college or university at the time the award is issued and be enrolled in the first fall term immediately following graduation.
- ✧ Applicant must provide proof of a cumulative grade point average not to exceed 85 percent or fall below 75 percent.
- ✧ Applicant must provide proof of participation in community service completed in the calendar year of the applicable school year (i.e. 2007 graduates must provide proof of participation in community service during the calendar years of either 2006 or 2007).
- ✧ Applicant must provide a minimum of one written recommendation from a Samuel Gompers Vocational and Technical High School faculty member.
- ✧ Applicant must complete an essay of a minimum of 250 words detailing what it means to be a Finer Woman.
